

RESOLUTION NO. 25-2019

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA REQUESTING THAT THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, EARLY EDUCATION SERVICES DIVISION REIMBURSE FUNDS FOR THE EMERGENCY CLOSURE OF THE CHILD CARE SCHOOL-AGE AND PRESCHOOL PROGRAMS DUE TO THE EMERGENCY CLOSURE OF PROGRAMS ON NOVEMBER 16, 2018 DUE TO POOR AIR QUALITY AS A RESULT FROM NEARBY CAMP FIRE IN PARADISE, CALIFORNIA.**


**WHEREAS**, The City of Pacifica Parks, Beaches and Recreation Department, Child Care Division, provides child Care services through a contract with the State of California Department of Education, Early Education Services Division; and

**WHEREAS**, The State of California requires that in the case of emergency closures a resolution requesting reimbursement be made by the contracted agency; and

**WHEREAS**, Due to poor air quality as a result of nearby "Camp Fire" in Paradise, California, on November 16, 2018, the City of Pacifica Child Care's twelve school-age and one full-day preschool classrooms had an emergency closure at Cabrillo, Ocean Shore, Sunset Ridge, Vallemar and Fairmont West;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE PACIFICA CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

that the City of Pacifica requests that the California Department of Education reimburse funds for the emergency closure of the twelve school-age and one full-day preschool classrooms operated by the City of Pacifica, for one non-operating day for 107 certified children in the fiscal year of 2018-2019.




