A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA ADOPTING BUDGET ADJUSTMENTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-19 TO FUND FIRE ENGINE PURCHASE

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed the budget update and desires to approve the following budget adjustments for FY 2018-19 to fund the purchase of a fire engine.


FURTHER RESOLVED, that the maximum principal amount of the lease agreement or other obligations expected to be issued for the Project is \$602,083.05.
