Attention! Pacifica Restaurants and Food Facilities:

On March 14, 2022, the Pacifica City Council adopted a Disposable Foodware Ordinance, prohibiting the use of non-compostable, disposable food service ware. This new regulation became enforced October 1, 2022.

The City Council adopted <u>additional</u> provisions which will require food facilities to provide <u>reusable foodware and utensils</u> <u>for dine - in customers</u>. Enforcement begins June 1, 2023.

Many entities that have a valid health permit with the County of San Mateo to provide prepared food and beverages to the public within Pacifica will be impacted by the new regulation.

- Health Coverage Statements: Forms 1095-A, B or C
- Childcare provider information
- total amount paid to the daycare provider
- daycare provider's tax identifying number (SSN or EIN)
