On March 14, 2022, the Pacifica City Council adopted a Disposable Foodware Ordinance, prohibiting the use of non-compostable, disposable food service ware. This new regulation became enforced October 1, 2022.

The City Council adopted <u>additional</u> provisions which will require food facilities to provide <u>reusable foodware and utensils for dine - in customers</u>. Enforcement begins June 1, 2023.

Many entities that have a valid health permit with the County of San Mateo to provide prepared food and beverages to the public within Pacifica <u>will be impacted</u> by the new regulation.




years. The program is for workplaces, multidwellings, public parking areas, and other public locations to improve access to EV charging and accelerate the adoption of electric vehicles.
