

RESOLUTION NO. 103-2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH R V STICH CONSTRUCTION, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$190,576.00; AUTHORIZE A BUDGET AUTHORITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$220,000.00, WHICH INCLUDES CONTINGENCIES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIFTEEN PERCENT (15%) OF THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT AMOUNTS; AUTHORIZE STAFF TO EXECUTE FUTURE CHANGE NOT TO EXCEED THE CONTINGENCY AMOUNT; AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN CONTRACT DOCUMENTS RELATED TO THE 330 ESPLANADE SOIL NAIL WALL PROJECT

WHEREAS, consistent with the City of Pacifica's Purchasing Policy (Administrative Policy No. 76 – Article 7), the City of Pacifica procured bids under the exemption from competitive pricing procedures in order to protect health and safety; and

WHEREAS, recent winter storms combined with extreme high tides and waves have caused additional erosion directly behind soil nail wall at 330 Esplanade Avenue ("Property"), further eroding the bluff and the soil nail wall; and

WHEREAS, it is predicted that additional winter storm events this winter combined with high tides and waves could cause further severe bluff erosion and subsidence, and it is thus imperative that the soil nail wall is removed at the Property before further significant bluff erosion occurs causing the soil nail wall to fall.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Pacifica to authorize the City Manager to entering into the construction contract and agreement for the removal of the soil nail wall with Stich Construction, Inc. and authorize the City Manager to sign the project contract documents for the Governing Board.
