Employment Training Panel

If you are having trouble attracting customers, it might be a sign that you need to improve and update the way you interact with your customers online. Here are some quick questions to ask yourself:

Does your business need to train new workers or re-train existing workers? The Employment Training Panel (ETP) can help. ETP is a State organization that provides funding to employers to assist in upgrading the skills of their workers through training that leads to good paying, long-term jobs. Here's how it works: first, the business enters into an agreement with ETP that specifies how many employees need training and what kind of training they will receive (e.g., courses at a local college, other classroom learning or certifications, on-the-job training, etc.). After the training is completed, ETP reimburses the business for their training costs, up to an agreed-upon maximum. In one recent example, ETP reimbursed a company about \$40,000 to partially offset their training costs. If you are interested in learn more, please visit: https://etp.ca.gov

New Reporting Requirements for Small Businesses

The **Corporate Transparency Act**, which took effect in January 2024, requires small businesses with fewer than 20 employees to report their ownership information to the Department of the Treasury's Financial Crimes Enforcement Network as part of an effort to curb money laundering and illicit financial operation. Existing companies have one year to file and new companies must file within 90 days of creation or registration.

Black Founder Start Up Grant

The Black Founder Startup Grant program from the SoGal Foundation and other sponsors provides grants of up to \$10,000 to Black and multiracial women and nonbinary entrepreneurs. The program accepts applications on a rolling basis and is open to entrepreneurs with a legally registered business who plan to seek investor financing to scale.

To qualify, you should:

- self-identify as a Black woman or Black nonbinary entrepreneur (inclusive of multiracial Black women and multiracial Black nonbinary folks)
- have a legally registered business
- plan to seek investor financing in order to scale, now or in the future
- have a scalable, high-impact solution or idea with the ambition to be the next billion dollar business.

The Military Entrepreneur Challenge is a nationwide grant program that gives veteran, military spouse, and Gold Star family entrepreneurs the opportunity to compete for capital to grow their small business.
