

**RESOLUTION NO. 25-2024**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF PACIFICA AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF GRANT APPLICATIONS TO THE CALIFORNIA STATE PARKS DIVISION OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS FOR AN ARMY CORP OF ENGINEERS GENERAL STUDY OF PACIFICA'S COASTLINE AND BEACH BLVD. INFRASTRUCTURE RESILIENCY PROJECT (BBIRP)**

**WHEREAS**, Sections 65 through 67.4 of the Harbors and Navigation Code authorize the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways (DBW) to do the following: study erosion problems; act as shore protection advisor to all agencies of government; and plan, design and construct protective works when funds are provided by the Legislature. In addition, Sections 69.5-69.9 of the Harbors and Navigation Code authorize DBW to pursue and promote federal and local partnerships to restore, enhance, and nourish publicly owned beaches through the cost-effective engineered placement of sand on the beach or in the nearshore environment; and

**WHEREAS**, DBW is accepting grant applications for shoreline erosion control projects and public beach restoration projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pacifica has experienced extraordinary erosion along its shoreline and seeks the assistance of the US Army Corps of Engineers to conduct a General Study for shore protection; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Pacifica began the Beach Blvd. Infrastructure Resiliency Project for coastline projection by seeking funding to complete appropriate studies, design, and environmental review; and

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of these grants is to protect and identify the feasibility of protecting essential public infrastructure along the City's shoreline;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Pacifica formally approves the submittal of requests for grant funding from DBW for an Army Corp of Engineers General Study of Pacifica's coastline and BBIRP project;
