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## **Pacifica Special Needs Registry**

Pacifica, CA- The Pacifica Police Department's Special Needs Registry is a tool that allows us to better serve our community members with special needs. It will allow our officers quick access to information that will enable them to better assist that person during any contact, if they become lost, found, or when they need assistance.

Parents and care providers are able to enroll a person of any age with any medical, mental health condition or disability including, but not limited to, Alzheimer's Disease, Dementia, Bipolar Disorder, Autism Spectrum Disorder, Down Syndrome, or Epilepsy.

This registry will contain a photograph, physical description and emergency contact information for the person. It will also include information needed to find those who wander away from home and help identify "found" individuals. Important information about medical, safety and behavioral concerns will also be readily available to officers through the registry. Helpful suggestions for interacting with a person having a disability or medical condition may also be provided.
