Commercial Storm Water:

Under SB 205, the State Water Resources Control Board and the California Regional Water Quality Control Boards prescribe waste discharge requirements for the discharge of storm water by municipalities and industries in accordance with the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit program and the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act. The existing law requires regulated municipalities and industries to obtain a storm water permit. SB 205 requires specific types of businesses to demonstrate they have a storm water permit when applying for an initial business license or when renewing its business license with the city or county of jurisdiction.
