LINDA MAR PUMP STATION TEMPORARY WET WEATHER PUMPING AND STORAGE

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE (Pacifica, CA) – Starting December 17, 2018, the City's contractor, Rain For Rent, will begin the Linda Mar Pump Station Temporary Wet Weather Pumping And Storage project. The installation will last from Monday, December 17, 2018 to Friday, December 21, 2018. During the installation of this project, the south Linda Mar Beach parking lot will be closed to the public.

This project will install a temporary storage system consisting of 2 portable pumps and 16 tanks to pump and temporarily store wet weather sewage overflow, reducing the potential for release of untreated sewage. Each tank will have the capacity to store 21,000 gallons, for a total storage capacity of 336,000 gallons. The pumps and tanks will be temporarily setup adjacent to the Linda Mar Pump Station. The tanks and pumps will be set up, tested, and made ready for use prior to December 31, 2018. The system is temporary for winter months while the Wet Weather Equalization Basin is being completed.

The City appreciates everyone's patience and cooperation for any inconveniences caused by construction activities as we strive to improve human health and the environment in Pacifica.
